

LWVSC Non-Partisan Policy

NONPARTISAN POLICIES FOR STATE BOARD MEMBERS:

- A. In order to maintain the nonpartisan image of the League, a state board member must resign if she or he runs for a partisan political office elected by the general public, accepts appointment to such an office, or holds a partisan elective office. Public endorsement of any partisan candidate or party must be avoided by the president, Voter Services chair, and LWVSC authorized lobbyists. If there is any question about the political activity of any state board member, this should be brought before the state board for review and decision.

- B. If a spouse or partner of a state board member runs for any partisan political office, this need not disqualify the state board member from a position of the board. This should be brought before the state board for review and decision.

LWVSC Social Media Policy

A Board member shall not indicate her/his political affiliations or candidate preferences at any level of government in the media, including on social networking sites or other public venues that also prominently identify her/his as a member of the LWVSC.
